PRESERVED OR RESTORED? Boats are judged using ACBS guidelines which define preserved boats as those containing at least 60% of their original deck and topsides material and constructed using the same methods and materials as the original. Bottom replacement is expected in order for the boat to be serviceable but the method of replacement must duplicate the original. Owner's categorization will be accepted unless the judges find cause to determine otherwise, in which case the Chief Judge's determination will be final. **\*\*Does not apply to Contemporary Classifications\*\***
