Responsibilities

Instruction for Optimists and Sunfish

Work with youth, teens, and adults

Physically assist students in launching, rigging and storing boats

Be a responsible, reliable, enthusiastic presence with good judgment and leadership

Take responsibility for ensuring a safe, organized, and educational waterfront and fleet

Perform seamanship skills to include keeping boats, equipment, and storage facility clean and neat

Ensure preparation, planning and daily review and documentation of program

Communicate relevant history of the Thousand Islands Region to ABM students.

Instruct, evaluate and document improvement in sailing skills of all ABM students

May have to work evenings, or weekends for programs or special events
