- Not remain in or around the classroom area during class time and understand that parental
 presence during class can be distracting and detrimental to instruction. Please not that it is
 acceptable for parents to <u>briefly</u> stay for taking photos/videos of sailors.
- Guidelines for behavior in class that are conducive to a productive learning environment for all students. These include students being respectful of teachers, classmates and ABM equipment; listening and speaking in turn and as appropriate for a classroom setting and treating others as they would like to be treated.
