# Requirements

## Security Deposit:

For large scale events, a \$500 security deposit is due upon signing, and for small scale events a \$100 deposit is due upon signing.

## Payment Plans:

Payment plans are broken up into a monthly system- the first 25% is due in January of the rental year (or within a month after signing), 50% due 60 days prior, and the final 25% due 30 days prior.

## Event Insurance:

Event Insurance is required for every event, and a security attendant is required for all events with alcohol and/or taking place outside of business hours.

## Alcohol:

All alcohol must be served by a bartender, and events with alcohol must obtain a permit. No liquor is permitted on campus, only wine, beer, cider, and seltzer.
