

## <u>Need for Speed</u> Saturday, August 20, 2022

Dedicated to the late John "Skip" Rawson, former ABM Trustee and avid lover of all things fast

From gentleman racers to hydroplanes and vintage motorcycles to cars, Need for Speed, a new event, is a celebration of all things speed! Taking place August 20, 2022, Need for Speed will feature boats at the docks and ABM's boats doing "fly-bys" in French Creek Bay, and some very special vintage motorcycles on display in the Gordon Gallery including the 1930 Henderson KJ Streamline featuring Orley Ray Courtney's enclosed bodywork, and a flyover by Tora Tora at 1pm. Gentleman racers, trailer-launched hydroplanes, and vintage motorcycles and cars are strongly encouraged to participate. Crane-launched hydroplanes are welcome as land displays only.

**<u>Registration Fees:</u>** A \$45 registration fee is required for each entry. This includes admission to the Museum for two, morning refreshments and a welcome packet.

## Information for Exhibitors:

- "Fly-bys" will occur at 10:30, 12:30, and 3:00pm on a closed course and are intended as a photo opportunity for spectators. After ABM's boats have completed their laps, interested participants will be allowed to run a lap. Only one boat will be allowed on the course at a time.
- Entries/Displays can be put in place Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup> between 10-5pm and Saturday, August 20<sup>th</sup> between 8:30-10:00am. All entries/displays need to be in place by 10am on Saturday when the Museum opens.
- Security will be provided on museum grounds and dock areas Friday-Sunday from 6:00pm to 6:00am. Once the day's events are completed and the gates are secured, no one will be allowed on the museum grounds without authorization of the on-duty museum staff. In the case of severe weather, the professional guard service will allow only the owner/exhibitor access to the entries.
- All in-water entrants should bring adequate lines and fenders. Weather on the River can be severe. Your boat is your responsibility.
- Please send us a photograph of your entry with your registration. Photographs are kept for our records and may be used for publicity.
- Smoking is prohibited on site, in buildings, on grounds, at docks.
- Service dogs are the only dogs allowed on campus.
