2024 Antique Boat Show Information for Exhibitors

- All entries to be judged, including the Land Displays, must be in operable condition.
- Please Register Early In-water display is limited.
- Registration Deadline: July 12th entries submitted after July 12th will incur a \$25 late fee.
- Please note any special requests about docking on your registration form. We will do our best to accommodate you.
- No commercial vendors allowed on the waterfront campus of the Museum.
- All entrants should bring adequate lines and fenders. Weather on the River can be severe. Your boat is your responsibility.
- Security will be provided on museum grounds and dock areas Thursday - Sunday from 6:00 pm to 6:00 am. Once the day's events are completed and the evening gates are secured, no one will be allowed on the museum grounds without authorization of the on-duty museum staff. In the case of severe weather, the professional quard service will allow only owner access to the registered boats.
- Note: Attractive documentation designed to help viewers learn more about your boat's history is encouraged

- Please send us a photograph of your boat with your application. Photographs are kept for our records and may be used for publicity.
- No "For Sale" signs allowed on a boat. A "For Sale" board will be available on the grounds.
- Smoking is prohibited on site, in buildings, on grounds, at docks.
- No dogs are allowed on site.
- All entries should remain on display until the Parade on Sunday for the benefit of our spectators who visit the show on Sunday.

Preserved, Restored, or Resto-Mod?

For a wooden boat to be considered "Preserved" it must retain at least 60% of the original deck and topsides material and be constructed using the same methods and materials as the original.

Owner's categorization will be accepted unless the judges find cause to determine otherwise, in which case the Chief Judge's determination will be final.

Classification

Historic – Built prior to 1919 Antique – Built 1919 – 1942 **Classic** – Built 1943 – 1975

Late Classic – Built after 1975. In 2024 the Late Classic period ends in 1999

Contemporary – A wooden boat built in the last 25 years
