Highly effective interpreters will engage and capture their audience ultimately enhancing the guest experience.

## **Responsibilities**

- Efficiently open and close *La Duchesse* each day
- Closely interact with the Admissions Team to Inform visitors of tour availabilities
- Lead historically accurate tours using interpretive materials developed by the Museum's Education and Curatorial Depts.
- Ensure guests are informed of safety precautions while on the tour
- Perform routine cleaning of La Duchesse
- Execute regular inspections of La Duchesse to verify contents
